This has been a wonderful year full of blessings. BWM has had the chance to visit with new prospective Mission Areas in Brazil and Bolivia - getting in on the ground floor of what some day could be full Unity Provinces.



The BWM had a strong presence at youth events both in North America as well as with our globa

both in North America as well as with our global partners. Nothing brings energy like summer camps, regardless of language!

Mission experiences and mission teams have started back up again as we move further away from some of the biggest restrictions of the pandemic.

The BWM was able to work with so many partners in our church to help more than double the \$50,000 goal of our Debt Jubilee Project, with more than \$102,000 raised to relieve over \$10 million in debt for 13,000+ families. Now, as we near the end of the year, we find ourselves with energy building around the new water filter distribution project in Honduras, aptly named "Blessings Flow". This summer, generous Moravians came together to offer grace and hope through the forgiveness of medical debt, both here in the United States and at the Moravian medical ministry in Ahuas, Honduras. The Debt Jubilee Project: For the Healing of the World was a collaborative effort of several Moravian agencies based on our biblical call to care for the sick and our belief that healthcare is a fundamental human right. We are pleased to share that this project is making a huge impact around the world and close to home.

Total Impact

- Total Amount Received: \$102,424.47 (more than double our goal!)
- Total sent to the Ahuas Clinic: \$25,606.12
- Total sent to abolish medical debt in the U.S.: \$76,818.35

Through our partnership with RIP Medical Debt, total debt abolished in the U.S.: \$10,965,390.60.

People impacted: 13,441 individuals / families in 37 counties across 15 states where Moravian congregations and entities are located.
44 families in La Moskitia, Honduras.

Putting this in perspective: When all is said and done, the number of people impacted by the Debt Jubilee Project will eclipse the populations of Lake Mills, WI (6,433); Lititz, PA (9,527); Waconia, MN (13,071); the Southern Province (13,114); and the majority of the Northern Province (18,395).

Blessings Flow

The Board of World Mission's Blessings Flow Project has provided clean water to over 400 families in the La Moskitia region of Honduras this year through the distribution of household water filters. Through a partnership with local leaders and an organization called One Atta Time, which provides five-gallon buckets, EPA-approved water filters, and assessments of health and water quality, we have blessed every family in the villages of Tumtum Tara and Warunta, with plans to serve three additional communities (Kuhrpa, Pakwi, and Río Plátano) in the first stage of the project.

This project has already touched the hearts of many North American Moravians, who have assembled water filters, contributed to joyful noise offerings, and welcomed BWM staff members into their congregations to share about the project. We are deeply grateful to all who have engaged with this effort through recent Moravian Day of Service activities and beyond. At the bottom of this page, you will find a daily Advent calendar that will help you learn more about the project and count your blessings in this Advent season.

As we approach the end of the year, now is the best time to let the Blessings Flow!

Our partners at One Atta Time are graciously extending the price of \$50 per filter to our Moravian donors through the end of the year, despite having increased their general rate to \$100 this summer (to match increases in the cost of supplies, travel, water testing, and other services they provide). This means that by giving before December 31st, the impact of your donation will be doubled!

Your \$50 donation covers the cost of purchasing the filter, shipping costs to get it in country, the purchase of the bucket, visits by BWM and One Atta Time staff to do health assessments, filter distribution, training on how to use and maintain the filter, and a follow-up visit to measure impact and ensure continued proper usage. That's a lot of value to give EVERY family in these communities a decade or more of clean water to limit days of work and school lost to the effects of waterborne illnesses!

Even more important, this is a project carried out jointly by the leadership of the two Moravian Church bodies in Honduras. The church, which split more than 25 years ago, is finding ways to work together in mission that transcend their historical division. This display of unity is a tremendous witness to these communities.
