



2022 Synod Nominations Committee  
Seeks Nominees for Provincial Boards, PEC, and Unity Synod

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Moravian Church, Southern Province Synod of 2022 will be taking place June 1<sup>st</sup>- 4<sup>th</sup> at Winston-Salem State University in Winston-Salem, NC. Our theme for this upcoming synod is “God Is in the Other Place.” The Nominations Committee is seeking individuals who are willing to offer their leadership by giving of their time and talent in a variety of ways.

At this synod, delegates will elect people to serve 4-year terms on PEC and provincial boards, plus attend Unity Synod. The Nominations Committee is currently requesting applications for the following:

- Board of Directors, Mission Society – 12 positions
- Board of Trustees, Moravian Theological Seminary – 2 positions
- Board of Directors, Salemtowne – 4 positions
- Board of World Mission – 2 positions
- Provincial Women's Board – 10 positions
- Unity Synod (2023) – 2 delegates, at least one must be female (determined at the last Unity Synod)
- Provincial Elders' Conference -- 3 clergy positions, 3 layperson positions (the PEC President will be elected at Synod by ecclesiastical ballot without nomination)

Application Process

All are welcome to apply for nomination for a position NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 20, 2021.

--- To apply as a candidate for nomination to any of the provincial boards, a **Provincial Board Candidate INFORMATION** form is available on the Southern Province website.

--- To recommend someone as a candidate for nomination to a board, a **Provincial Board Candidate RECOMMENDATION** form is available on the website.

--- Those interested in service on the Provincial Elders' Conference should complete the **PEC Candidate Information** form found on the website.

There are two ways to submit these three forms. You may download and print the form from the website, then mail it to the following address:

**All candidates must complete a candidate information form and provide a recent photograph.**

### Nominations Process

The Nominations Committee reviews all candidate information and determines which candidates best qualify to become official nominees for the 2022 synod elections. The committee also notifies all possible candidates about whether or not they are selected for formal nomination on the ballot. Then an election booklet is created, including descriptions of every board, and all the individual candidate information with pictures. That booklet will be forwarded to every synod delegate for review in early April, 2022.
